How to reach the city center and the venue from Athens International airport?

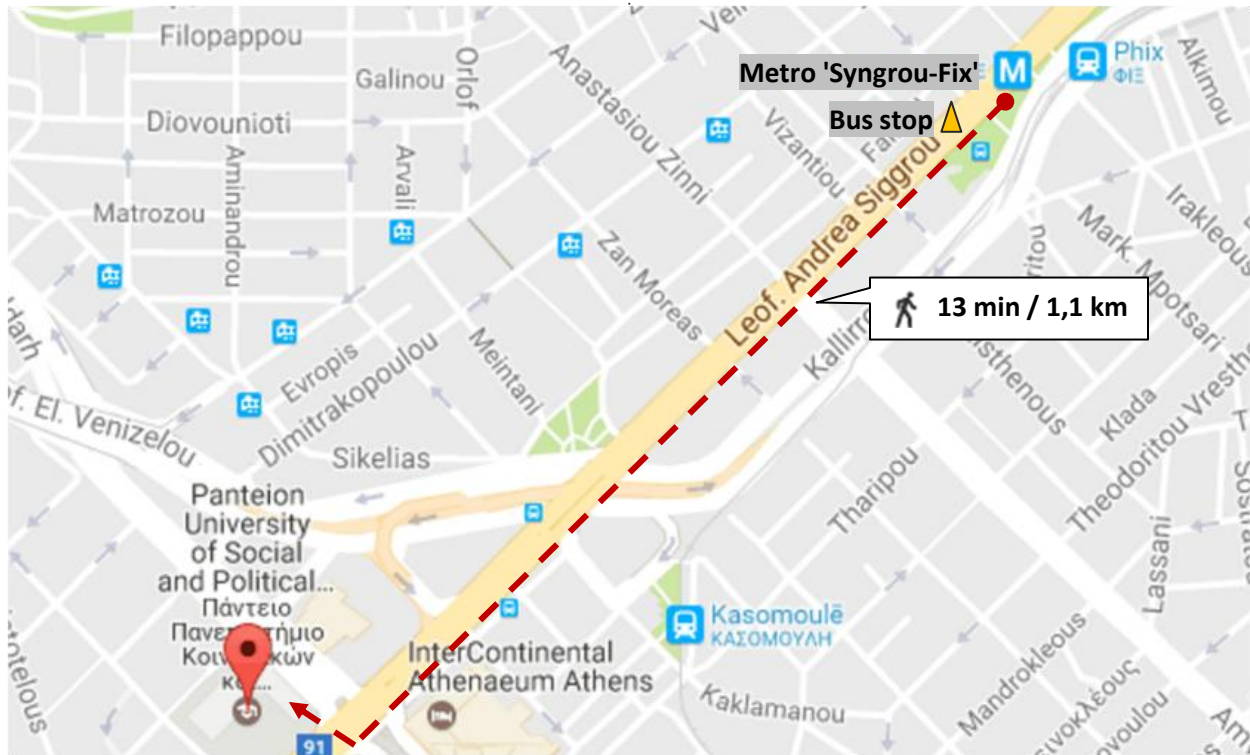
Eleftherios Venizelos International Airport is 27km east of downtown Athens and well connected to Athens by public transportation. In order to reach the venue you can either take the Bus, Metro or a taxi.

By Metro: Metro **Line 3** runs from the airport to the city center stations. You can stop at 'Syntagma' (Σύνταγμα) and change to **Line 2** (direction towards Agios Dimitrios) and stop to 'Syngrou - Fix'.

From Syngrou Fix you can either walk (10-14') to Panteion or take a bus. When you take off at the metro, you take the exit (Syngrou-Drakou) walk a few meters on Leof. Andrea Syngrou until you will find the bus stop on your right. All buses 040, 106, 126, 134, 135, 136, 137, 550, A2, B2, E22, E90 and the trolley No 10 stop at Panteion University, 3 stops after Syngrou Fix)

Ticket Price: From the airport prices are €10, €18 if in a group of 2, 24 in a group of 3, and €18 return (good for up to 48 hours).

Duration: The trip to 'Syntagma' from the airport takes 45 minutes. The train runs from 6:30 to 23:30. To check the timetable click [here](#)



NOTICE!: Metro Line 3 from/to the airport departs every 30 minutes. During 2017 the Athens transport ticket system will transition from paper tickets to modern electronic tickets with the use of plastic smartcards.

By Bus: If you're arriving or departing at night then the bus is a good alternative to the metro as it runs 24 hours. The bus is the cheapest way between the airport and downtown. You buy your ticket at the kiosk before boarding and validate your ticket on board. Late at night you can purchase your ticket from the driver on the bus.

- [X95](#) – Direct Connection to Syntagma Square (last stop) at Athens city center. **To arrive to the Conference Venue you can change to [Line 2](#) (direction towards Agios Dimitrios) and stop to 'Syngrou - Fix'**. Every 15 to 30 minutes. For the timetable click [here](#)
- [X96](#) – To Piraeus/Ferry Port, arrives in 45 to 90 minutes. Every 15 to 30 minutes.
- [X93](#) – To Kifissos Bus Terminal A (for buses to Peloponnese, Thessaloniki, Corfu) in 60 minutes. Every 30 minutes.

Ticket Price: € 6 (only one-way tickets)

Duration: Approximately 1 hour trip depending on the traffic conditions (The heaviest traffic times are 7:30am to 9:30am and 4pm to 6pm).

By Taxi : Taxi from the airport to central Athens is done on a flat fee and cost €35 through the day and €50 from midnight to 5am. From the airport to Piraeus by taxi costs €40 through the day and €60 at night (but this is not flat fee so watch the meter or pre-arrange the rate with your driver).

Accommodation

The areas indicated on the map with circles are all appropriate for booking a hotel. We suggest neighborhoods near the venue or with a good metro connection such as Koukaki (M. Syngrou-Fix), Syntagma, Acropolis, Monastiraki, Panepistimio.
